# USA POSTAGE

## \$100

- The Jamestown Exposition Issues of 1907 depicted the FOUNDING of JAMESTOWN on one of the 3 issues. Here is the 2 cent Carmine issue.

There was a 1 Cent and 5 Cent issue as well. WHO was shown on each of the other two stamps issued?



# USA POSTAGE \$200

- Here are some of the issues from the 1932 Washington Bicentennial which served as the 200<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of George Washington's Birth.



How many stamps were issued in commemoration of George Washington's bicentennial of his birth? What was the lowest denomination among the issues?



# USA POSTAGE \$400

In 1998 the United States Postal Service issued 10 sheets as part of the CELEBRATE THE CENTURY series of stamps. Here is one example from the panel for the decade of 1970.



The circled stamp shows the **ALL IN THE FAMILY** stamp. The show has 4 main characters. What were the character's names?

# USA POSTAGE \$500



Here we have Scott Number RW48, one of many DUCK STAMPS produced by the United States. As can be seen the stamps have the words U.S. Department of the Interior indicated on the stamps and the stamp provided proof of a permit to hunt.

Prior to 1939 the DUCK STAMPS were not issued by the Department of the Interior. What department actually issued the stamps?

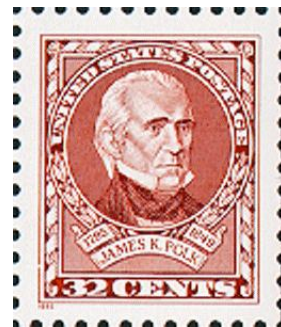

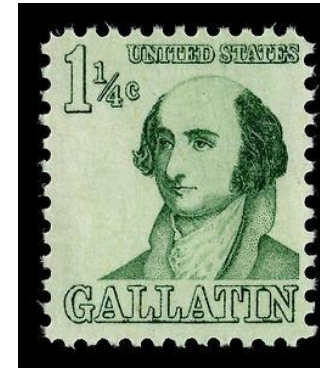

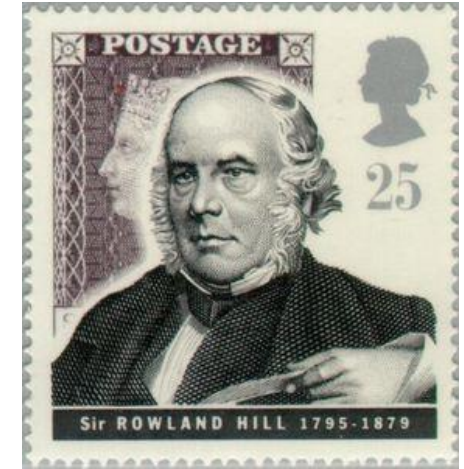
