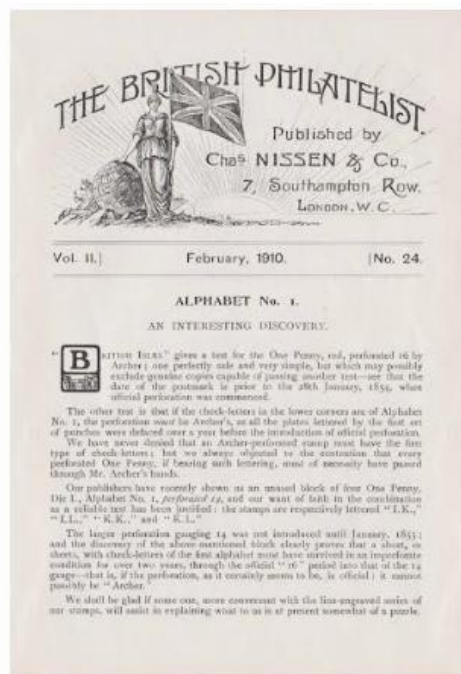

What we know (as of March 2026):

- All 59 known copies are from the same sheet
- Printed from plate #74, in use from 1847 to 1848
- Perforated 14, a gauge not used in Britain until 1855
- NOT Comb perforated, the primary British method
- NOT Line perforated, used, for example, in North America

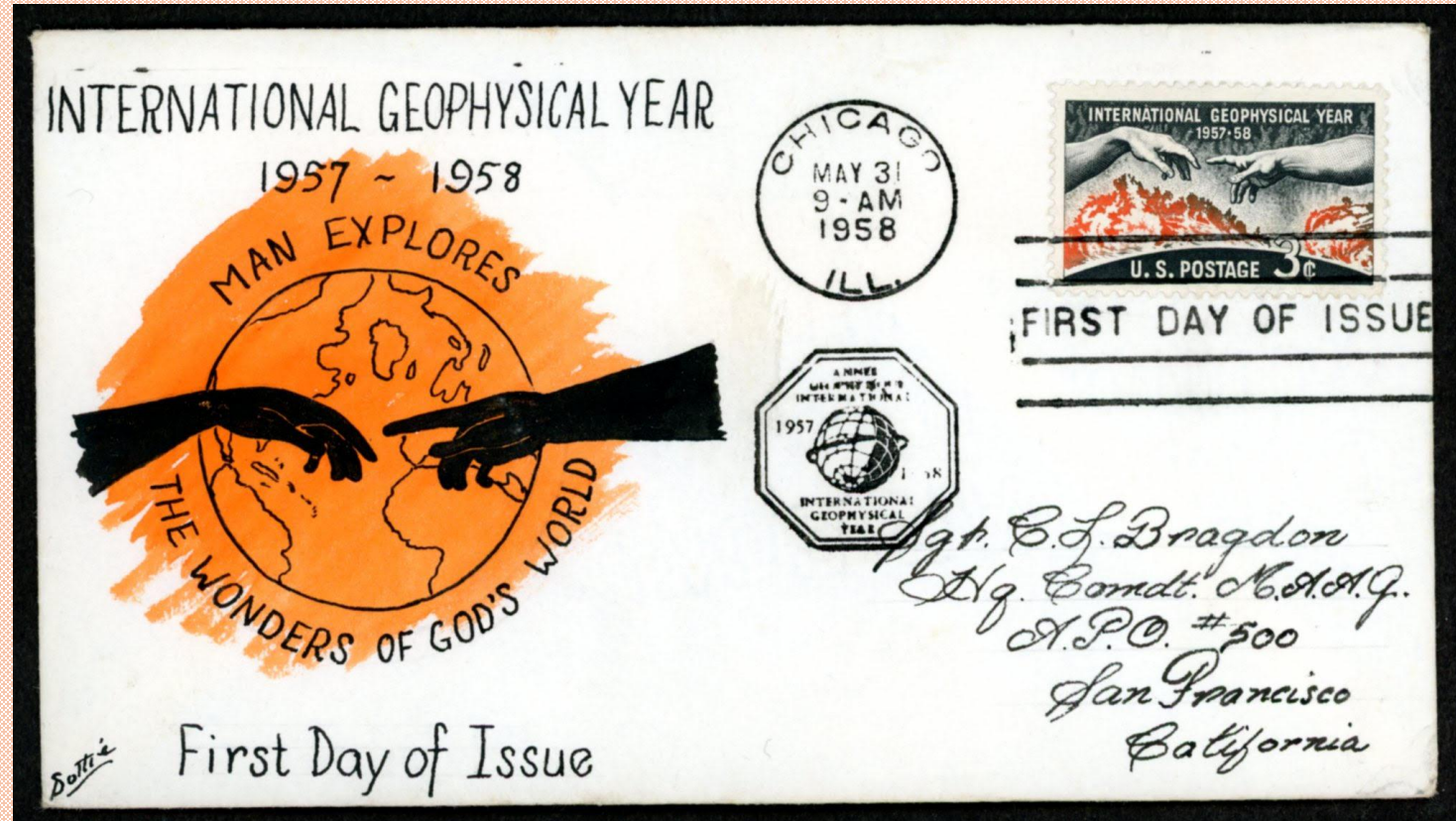


Block EF - HL, the largest (known) surviving block

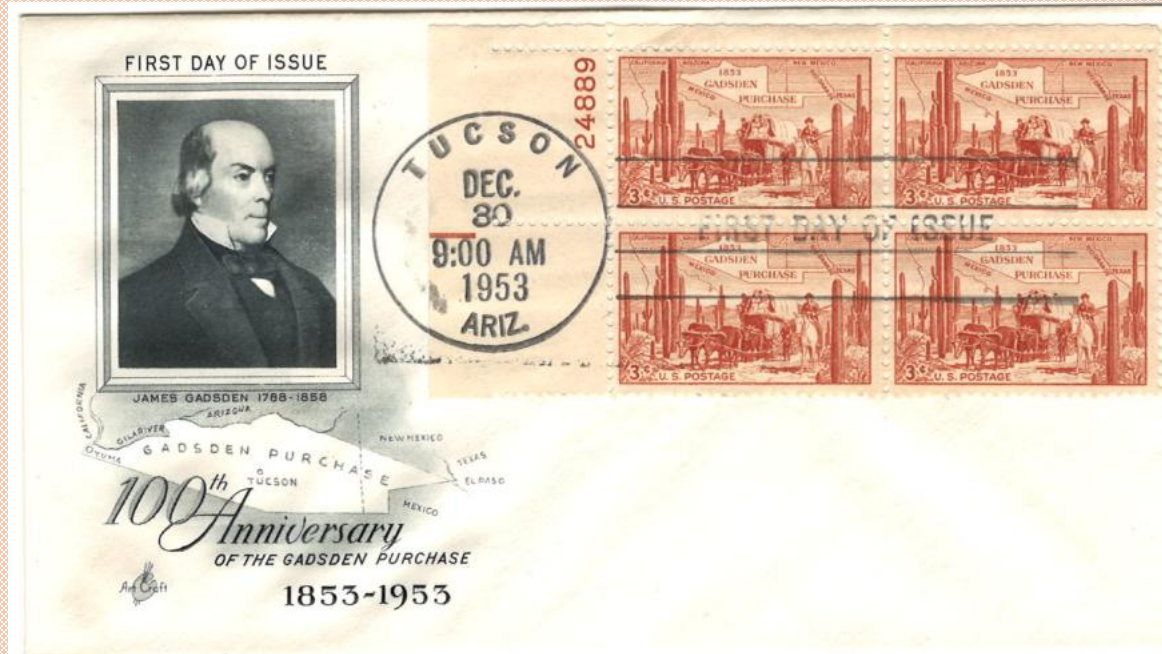

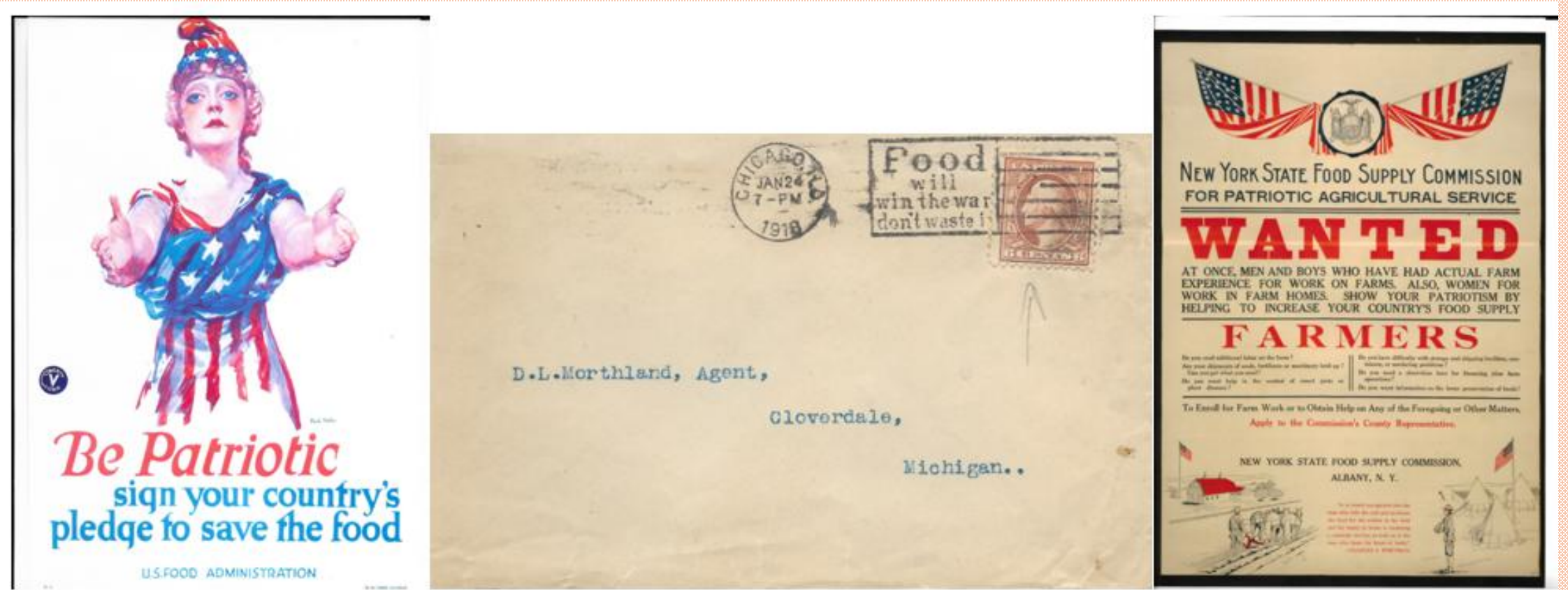
